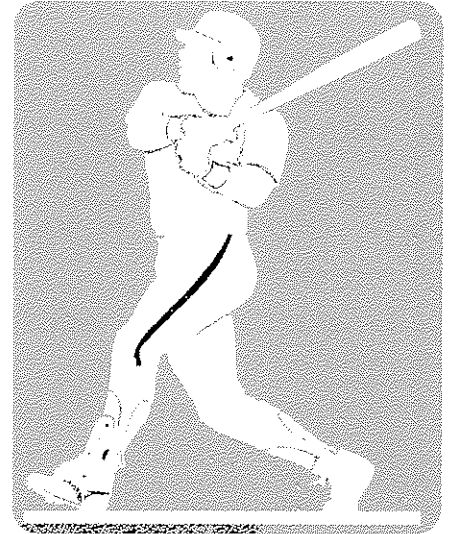

GENERAL INFORMATION

PURPOSE OF CAMP

The primary purpose is to teach skills in fundamentally sound baseball and to develop proper playing habits. With these goals in mind, we strive to develop the future athlete's ideas in sportsmanship, leadership, and citizenship.

Practice sessions will emphasize skills, fundamentals in hitting, defense, pitching, and base running. Individual instruction is given to help the campers correct faults or to perfect the skills he is developing.

Hard work and fun are coordinated to bring out the most in a boy. We make every effort for the camp to be a gratifying and worthwhile experience for every camper.

STAFF

Instruction will be provided by the NEMCC staff and several outstanding coaches and players from the Northeast Mississippi area. Camp directors will be Northeast Tiger Baseball Coaches Kent Farris and Clint McAuley.

AGES

Students who will be entering the first grade in the fall of 2009 through age 12 are eligible. Applications accepted on a first-come first-serve basis.

COSTS

The cost will be \$65.00 for the entire session. The price includes refreshments and a camp t-shirt. Accident medical insurance is included in the camp tuition.

SESSIONS

Each camp day will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude at 12 noon. Campers will be given a break in the morning. Campers will be supervised at all times by the instructors.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF CAMPERS

Campers should report each day to the Harold T. White Baseball Field by 9:00 a.m. Campers will be dismissed at 12 noon each day and should be picked up at the baseball field.

ITEMS NEEDED FOR CAMP

Each camper will need their own glove. If they bring their own bat, it needs to be marked in some manner with their names. It is recommended that shorts not be worn if they have a uniform to wear.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Each camper will be expected to comply with the rules for the camp and must follow instructions given by the camp director and instructors. Any violation or abuse of the camp rules will result in immediate dismissal from the camp without any refund.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

A camper who has specific medical instructions must provide a note from parent or guardian; this should be sent in with the application form.
