What are we doing for the senior camp and why?

The workout will consist of stretching and agilities, each participant will get 4 bunts and eight swings running the last one out for a time, the coaching staff will offer tips and suggestions for improvement

Then we will throw to get loose:

Infielders will make 3 throws to each base; outfielders will make 3 throws to each base.

Pitchers will get loose and throw 25 pitches of your choice to our catchers; catchers will demonstrate blocking skills and make 3 throws to each base.

We will finish with one time to 1st, 2nd home and final comments from coaching staff.

Why do I need to come to senior camp? If you are serious about softball and have the desire to play at the college level then you need to come. Those who attend will show the coaches they are willing to work. This is the best way for you to show off your skills, get tips on improving your game and learn what it takes to be a Tiger!
