Board of Trustees Meeting – April 14, 2009

- Consideration of Property for Sale Franks Street – The Board approved to make a counter offer on property that is located at 201 Franks Street that is owned by the Echols Family. An appraisal and inspection revealed the property to be good condition.
- Approval to remove house owned by Northeast at 207 Franks Street – The Board approved to offer the house, located at 207 Franks street, to any party that is willing to move the house from the property. If no one is interested, the house will be demolished.
- Request by South Corinth Focus Group – The South Corinth Focus Group inquired about the Board’s interest in occupying space in a building at the Corinth Elementary School. The Board agreed to decline the offer as Northeast still has space available at the Northeast at Corinth center.
- Meeting with Representatives of Redd Realty – The Buildings and Grounds Committee held a meeting with representatives from Redd Realty, who is interested in acquiring property from the College. The Board agreed that there was no interest in selling college property.
- Ratification of Bids for Used Buses - The following bids were accepted by the Board for the sale of two buses by Northeast. 1) 1973 Silver Eagle – Constantino Loueza - \$2,500; 2) 1974 Silver Eagle – Frank Garrison- \$2,777.
- Approval of Supplemental Personnel - The Board approved supplemental personnel as presented by the various divisions.
- Approval of Location of Classes - The Board approved to hold summer classes 2009 at the following locations: Booneville Campus, Northeast at Corinth and Northeast at New Albany.
- Approval of Curriculum Changes – The Board approved curriculum changes as submitted by the Curriculum Review Committee.
