

MLA list of Works Cited Examples (revised 9/2009) MLA Handbook 7th ed.

Electronic Sources

Work from a Library Subscription Service (online databases) Note: Use whatever information is available.

AuthorLastName, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Internet site or Database* Ed. first last name. Identifying volume number (Date of Publication): *If no vol. number is available, date of publication appears without parenthesis* page no. Name of Publisher. Web. Day Month Year when source accessed. *If no publisher is listed, use "n.p." to denote no publisher name. For databases that do not provide page numbers, use the abbreviation "n. pag." for no pagination (capital "N" is used if it follows a period; lower case "n" is used if it follows a colon). List the medium of publication -examples: "Web", "Print", "DVD", "Audio".*
